Present Perfect Simple (Παρακείμενος απλός)

Formation: have / has + P.P. of a verb

I have travelled to Athens many times .

I have gone to athens for holidays.

He/she/it has played with a toy.

I have not (haven't) studied for my classes.

She has not (hasn't) slept a lot tonight.

Have you done your homework? - Yes, I have.
No, I haven't.

Has the football match ended? - Yes, it has.
No, it hasn't.

Past Simple (Αόριστος απλός) σελ. 169

Formation: past tense (affirmative form)

modal: did + infinitive (negative-question form)

Ex: I travelled to Athens last week.

She played with her brother yesterday.

We went home late last night.
