Πότε τον χρησιμοποιούμε:

1. Για πράξεις που βρίσκονταν σε εξέλιξη σε μια συγκεκριμένη χρονική στιγμή στο παρελθόν.

Ex. I was speaking to Bill on the phone at 11 o'clock last night.

2. Για πράξεις που συνέβαιναν ταυτόχρονα για κάποιο χρονικό διάστημα στο παρελθόν.

Ex. While / As Max was getting dressed, I was having breakfast.

3. Για να περιγράψουμε το σκηνικό μιας αφήγησης / ιστορίας.

Ex. It was a cold winter's day. It <u>was snowing</u> outside and we <u>were sitting</u> around the fireplace.

I fell off my bike while / as I was cycling to school.

Negative X

I / he / she / it wasn't cleaning You / we / you / they weren't cleaning

Interrogative ?

Was I / he / she / it cleaning ?

Were you / we / you / they cleaning ?

Short answers:

- Were you cleaning your bedroom at that moment?
- Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.
- Was she having lunch at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon?
- Yes, she was. / No, she wasn't.
