used to talk about general truths and general habits If you add one and one, you get two.

I CONDITIONAL

used to talk about possible or likely things to happen in the future If your parents find out about

your lies, you will be grounded for weeks.

Unless (=if not) you help me, I won't manage to do it on time.

II CONDITIONAL

used to talk about impossible things in the present or unlikely things to happen in the future If I won the lottery, I would buy a luxury yaCht.

III CONDITIONAL

used to speculate about things which refer to the past If I hadn't been notoriously late, my boss wouldn't have fired me.

MIXED CONDITIONALS

used to refer to different times in two parts of a conditional sentence If] were you,] wouldn't have quit the job.

If I hadn't Crashed the Car, my parents wouldn't be mad with me now.
