COUNTABLE NOUNS

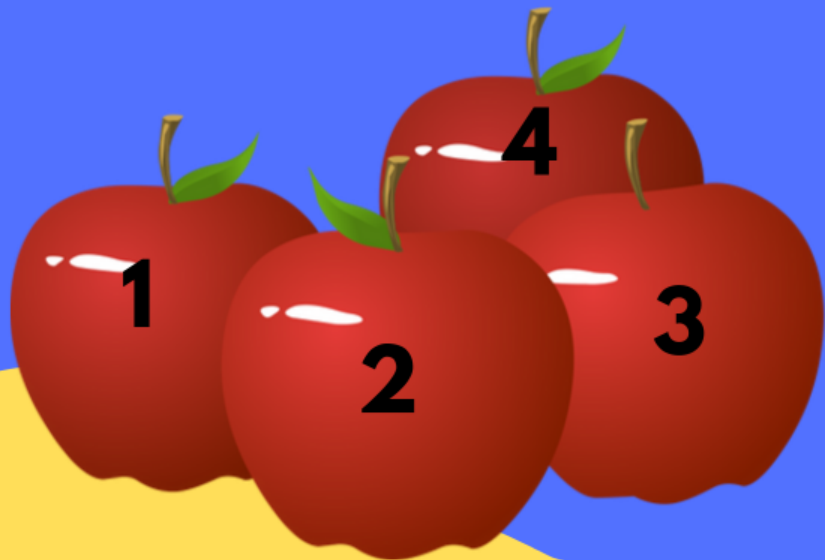
Countable nouns refer to things that can be counted. They have singular and plural forms.

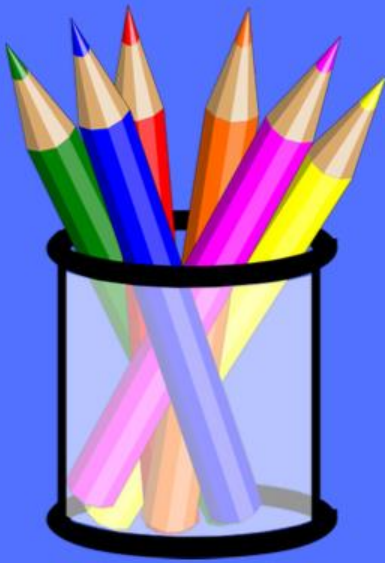

Uncountable nouns refer to things that CAN'T be counted.

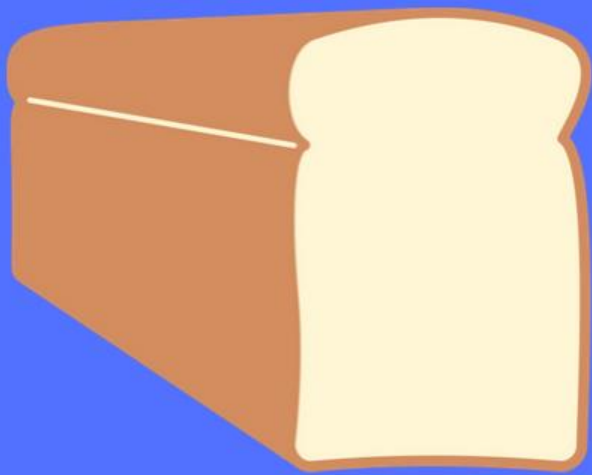
EXAMPLE:

We use '**many**' with **countable nouns** in **QUESTIONS** and in **NEGATIVE SENTENCES**.

How **many** apples
do you have?

There aren't **many**
apples.

We use '**much**' with **uncountable nouns** in **QUESTIONS** and in **NEGATIVE SENTENCES**.

Example:
QUESTIONS

How **much** money
do you have?

Example:
NEGATIVE SENTENCES

I don't
have **much** money.
