

#### e.g. I <u>was having</u> dinner at 8 o'clock yesterday evening.

# Form was/were+verb-ing

#### **Affirmative**

I was working You were working

#### **Interrogative**

Was I working? Were you working?



# Negative

### **Full Form**

#### I was not working You were not working



## Short Form

#### I wasn't working you weren't working





# • An action in progress in the past e.g. She was cooking at the time of the earthquake.

## To express an activity in progress which is interrupted by a simple past activity

e.g. She was making a salad when she cut her finger.

## To express simultaneous actions in the past

e.g. My mum <u>was making</u> lunch while my dad <u>was</u> <u>watching</u> T.V.
