# Use

- To talk about **past habits**  
(that no longer happen)

e.g. My dad used to smoke but now he doesn't.

# Simple Past –Used to

- We can use the Simple past instead of Used to without any difference in meaning when we talk about past habits

e.g. He used to wear glasses.

He wore glasses.



## But

e.g. She went to the cinema yesterday.

e.g. She ~~used to go~~ to the cinema yesterday.

- an action that happened at a particular time in the past
