

The Sydney Opera House



- The **Sydney Opera House** is a performing arts centre in Sydney, Australia.
- Designed by **Danish architect Jørn Utzon**, it formally opened on 20 October 1973.
- It's the busiest performing arts centres in the world — hosting over 1,500 performances each year attended by some 1.2 million people.
- The Sydney Opera House became an **UNESCO World Heritage Site** on 28 June 2007.
