quiet (adj) Opp.: noisy (adj)	ήσυχος e.g. Libraries are quiet places.
traffic (n)	κυκλοφορία (οχημάτων) e.g. There is a lot of traffic on the roads this evening.
industry (n)	βιομηχανία e.g. Most of the country's industry is in the Northwest.
(be) right (adj)	(έχω) δίκιο e.g. You're right ; that is a beautiful painting.
apart from Syn. : except for	εκτός από e.g. Apart from me, none of my classmates delivered the composition on time.
main (adj)	κύριος e.g. The main reason we are here today is to discuss Tuesday's problem.
port (n)	λιμάνι e.g. Evelyn went down to the port to watch the ships sailing in and out.
island (n)	νησί e.g. Have you ever been to the island of Hawaii?
dry (adj) Opp. : wet (adj)	ξηρός, στεγνός e.g. The chair was dry because it was not in the rain.
vehicle (n)	όχημα e.g. Frank had to walk, as he didn't have a vehicle .
allow (v)	επιτρέπω e.g. Will your parents allow you to go to the dance?
means of transport (n)	μέσα μεταφοράς e.g. Her bicycle was her only means of transport .
mules and donkeys (n)	 μουλάρια και γαϊδούρια
foot (n) (pl) feet / on foot	πόδι e.g. It sometimes takes longer to drive than to get to work on foot .
steep (adj)	απότομος e.g. The house was at the top of a steep hill.
unusual (adj)	ασυνήθιστος e.g. Snow in June is unusual .

silent (adj)	σιωπηλός e.g. Simon asked Helen to tell him the truth, but she was silent .
library (n)	βιβλιοθήκη e.g. Libraries are quiet places.
