supplement (n)	ένθετο e.g. The Sunday paper was fat with all the supplements .
physically (adv)	σωματικά e.g. Martha is physically capable of doing this job.
compulsory (adj) Opp.: optional	υποχρεωτικός, necessary e.g. Foreign language classes are compulsory in this school.
education (n) Der. : educational (adj)	εκπαίδευση, schooling e.g. What education do you have? A college degree?
(make) an effort (n)	(κάνω) προσπάθεια, make an attempt e.g. He made an effort to clean the kitchen, but it wasn't very clean afterwards.
reach (v)	φθάνω e.g. The train reached its destination on time.
certain (adj)	συγκεκριμένος, σίγουρος e.g. Are you looking for a certain book or just browsing?
law (n) Der. : lawyer (n)	νόμος e.g. It is against the law to steal.
offer (v+n)	Προσφέρω, give/provide e.g. He offered her some potato chips.
Junior High School (n)	Γυμνάσιο
(Vocational) Senior High School (n)	(Επαγγελματικό) Λύκειο
option (n) Der. : optional (adj)	εναλλακτική (επιλογή) e.g. Your options are to go to university or to get a job.
altogether (adv)	εντελώς e.g. The display is altogether unacceptable.
continue (v) Opp. : stop	συνεχίζω, go on / carry on e.g. He continued his work without stopping for lunch.
attend (v) Der. : attendance (n)	παρακολουθώ μαθήματα/διαλέξεις, παραβρίσκομαι e.g. I attend English classes every Tuesday.
transfer from ... to ... (v)	μεταφέρομαι από ... σε ..., move from ... to ... e.g. The manager transferred the box of shoes to the other warehouse.
type (n)	είδος, kind/sort e.g. This type of food is my favourite.

change one's mind (phr) Opp. : make up one's mind	αλλάζω γνώμη e.g. I changed my mind and decided to go to the party after all.
condition (n)	προϋπόθεση e.g. I will do it - on one condition .
general (adj) Opp. : particular (adj)	γενικός e.g. The general feeling is that he made a big mistake.
almost (adv)	σχεδόν e.g. He was almost home when the car broke down.
specialize in (v) Der.: specialization	ειδικεύομαι σε e.g. As a lawyer he specialized in trademark law.
various (adj) Der. : variety (n) vary (v)	ποικίλος e.g. There were various responses - everything from denial to anger.
science (n) Der. : scientist (n) scientific (adj)	επιστήμη, φυσική +χημεία e.g. I will spent all night doing his homework for science .
subject (n)	σχολικό μάθημα, θέμα e.g. I am studying three subjects in the morning: Chemistry, English and French.
cover (v)	καλύπτω, include e.g. Does the cost of this ticket cover government fees, too?
therefore (adv)	συνεπώς, επομένως e.g. The children will be walking to the cathedral and therefore will need to wear suitable footwear and a sun hat or raincoat, depending on the weather.
probable (adj) Der. : probability (n)	πιθανός e.g. It's very probable that our money will run out next week.
choice (n) Der. : choose (v)	επιλογή e.g. He needs to make a choice between the apple and the orange.
on the part of [sb] (prep)	από πλευράς e.g. There is a strong desire on the part of new citizens to help shape the places in which they live.
High School leaver (n)	Απόφοιτος Γυμνασίου
area (n)	περιοχή, region e.g. There are parks and other green areas around the city.
